**Purpose:**

The purpose of the bronze cross guard is to assist the lifeguard in supervision of patrons within the facility and identification/prevention of risk. While doing so they must maintain a safe, clean and friendly environment for the community to use.

**Qualifications:**

1. Current Bronze Cross Certification
2. Current Standard First Aid and CPR-C
3. Current WHMIS certification

**Responsibilities:**

- Commitment to the YMCA Mission, Vision and Values.
- Model YMCA Values – Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.
- Communication and interaction with a positive and professional attitude in regards to public relations.
- Monitor chemical levels by completing pool water tests and record these where applicable.
  - Understands the dangers of chemicals used in the pool.
- Ability to identify potential risks and hazards.
- Maintain a constant level of alertness to prevent accidents.
- Quick and accurate responsiveness in accordance to facility procedures.
- Administer first aid and CPR as required.
- Participate in scheduled staff inservice and training events.
- Keeps records of all events using the applicable form.
  - Accident/ Incident Form.
  - Perform pool tests.
  - Time off request forms.
  - Pool statistics.
- Wear a designated uniform while on duty.
- Remain on duty as scheduled until you are relieved.
- Give the NLS guard breaks during their shift.
- Assist the NLS guard with any necessary tasks.
